On February 9, 2021, at or after 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 37101 Newark Blvd., Newark, CA, the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider:

A Minor Use Permit, to consider allowing a 4-story 100 bed assisted living facility on a property zoned Residential High Density (RH). The property is located at 6214 Thornton Avenue (APN: 092A-1036-029-02).

Any interested person or authorized agent may appear at the public hearing to be heard. The applicant and property owner, Ash Jain MD, is requesting to build a 100-bed memory care facility at 6214 Thornton Avenue. The proposed building will be 4-story and approximately 52,255 sq.ft. The property is zoned Residential High Density (RH) and a residential assisted living facility requires a minor use permit in this district. In addition, any building over 35 feet in height in the RH district also requires a minor use permit.
