Minutes March 11, 2021

#### A. ROLL CALL

Mayor Nagy called the meeting to order at 7:13 p.m. Present were Council Members Hannon, Collazo, and Freitas. Vice Mayor Bucci was noted absent.

## B. PRESENTATIONS

**1.** Introduction of employees

Mayor Nagy introduced Police Officers Brian Karrick, Andrew Garcia, and Sandra Soto.

**2.** Presentation on East Bay Community Energy (EBCE)

EBCE Public Engagement Manager Alex DiGiorgio gave a presentation (on file with City Clerk). He stated that EBCE is a power supplier committed to providing cleaner, greener electricity at lower rates. EBCE provides the electricity source, PG&E still provides gas, maintenance, and billing. He stated that four notices will be sent out providing options to opt out of EBCE for electricity or opt up to cleaner energy options. No action results in automatic enrollment.
