WHAT IS AN IMPACT FEE?

An **impact fee** is a fee that is imposed by a local agency on a new or proposed development project to help pay for all or a portion of the costs of providing public services to the new development. Impact fees are considered to be a charge on new development to help fund and pay for the construction or needed expansion of offsite capital improvements.

The following is a list of current impact fees:

1. Park Impact:

a. Projects w/o Dedicated Land

(1) Single-Family: \$30,580/dwelling unit(2) Multi-Family: \$22,018/dwelling unit

b. Projects with Dedicated Land

(1) Single-Family: \$9,174/dwelling unit

(2) Multi-Family: \$6,483/dwelling unit

2. Capital Facilities

a. Public Safety

Single-Family Residential: \$4,222/unit
Townhome: \$4,222/unit
Multi-Family Residential: \$2,533/unit
Commercial: \$0.74/sq.ft.
Manufacturing: \$0.31/sq.ft.
Distribution: \$0.61/sq.ft.

b. <u>Community Service/Facilities</u>

Single-Family Residential: \$2,827/unit
Townhome: \$2,827/unit
Multi-Family Residential: \$1,414/unit
Commercial: \$1.05/sq.ft.
Manufacturing: \$0.23/sq.ft.
Distribution: \$0.44/sq.ft.

c. <u>Transportation</u>

Single-Family Residential: \$6,084/unit
Townhome: \$3,163/unit
Multi-Family Residential: \$3,772/unit

(4) Commercial: \$5.39/sq.ft.
(5) Manufacturing: \$2.95/sq.ft.
(6) Distribution: \$5.89/sq.ft.

3. Housing

a. Housing Impact Fee

(1) First 1,000 sq.ft./unit*: \$24.51/sq.ft.

(2) All sq.ft./unit over 1,000 sq.ft.:

\$9.82/sq.ft.

*(No fee for the first 200 sq.ft. of a residential addition)

b. Non-Residential Development Housing Impact (revised annually)

(1) Commercial: \$4.40/sq.ft.
(2) Industrial: \$0.83/sq.ft.

4. Art in Public Places and Private Development

Residential (excluding affordable housing): \$270/unit
Retail: \$0.26/sq.ft.
Office: \$0.38/sq.ft.
Light Manufacturing/Warehouse: \$0.21/sq.ft.
High-Tech: \$0.41/sq.ft.

5. Community Development Maintenance Fee

(1) 0.5% of construction value
