I further agree that, if necessary, I will appear in court and testify under penalty of perjury as to the truth of the statements contained in this letter and that the fact that by this correspondence I have authorized the City of Newark to enforce trespass provisions of the Newark Municipal Code and to act as my agent to enforce said laws.

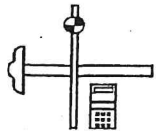

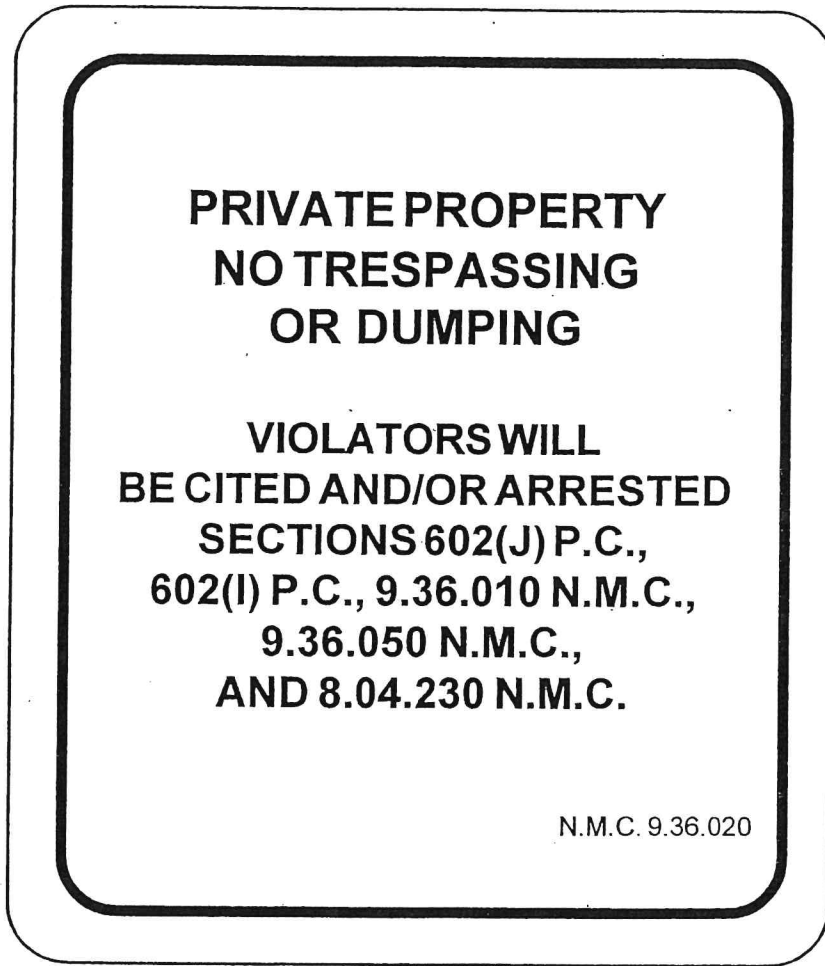

**Private Property Posting - No Trespassing/Dumping** Information Summary

The sign shown below may be used to prevent trespassing or dumping on private property by citation or arrest. The signs must be a minimum of 17" wide and a minimum of 22" high; minimum letter height size is also shown. Signs must be in plain view at all entrances to the property. Signs posted next to driveways must be positioned per the diagram shown below.
