The meeting will be held in the City Hall Council Chambers at 37101 Newark Boulevard, Newark, CA 94560. Members of the public may attend the meeting in person, virtually, or watch it via YouTube.

Pursuant to California Government Code §6061, §65090, §65091, §65094, §65095, §65905, and Newark Municipal Code (NMC) §17.31.060 and §17.35.050, on October 10, 2023, at or after 7:00 p.m., the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider:

1. U2023-002, A Conditional Use Permit for Seedling Child Care, a day care center use, at 5880 Thornton Avenue (APN 92A-1007-13-2). The subject site is zoned PO: Professional Office.

The applicant, Ahmed Belgaumi, is proposing a day care center use at 5880 Thornton Avenue. The property owner is Mosharof Hossain. The proposed day care center use would share the existing building with the existing tenants (i.e., Al Medina Education Center and Church of Christ). The applicant is proposing to occupy approximately 969 square feet of the existing building. The proposed day care center use would consist of 4 staff and a maximum capacity of 28 children. The hours of operation would be from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The project site is zoned PO: Professional Office and has a General Plan designation of Office Commercial. The project site is bounded by Thornton Avenue, Birch Street, Civic Terrace Avenue, and Saint Edwards Street. Pursuant to NMC 517.09.020, a day care center may be allowed with the approval of a Conditional Use Permit. The project is categorically exempt from CEQA as per CEQA Guidelines \$15301, which applies to existing facilities, and under CEQA Guidelines \$15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposal may have a significant effect on the environment.

Any interested person or authorized agent, or interested members of the public may appear at the public hearing to be heard and may submit written comments or request to view project details and information, including the complete
