This form shall be used for tracking and documentation. Applicants shall divert (recycle) no less than 65 percent of all construction and/ or demolition debris. **100% of asphalt and concrete should be recycled.** Quantities shall be based on weight unless volume is a more appropriate measurement. City Council resolutions for specific projects may have higher recycling standards. See the information and instructions page for more details.

Information and Instructions

These forms should be used by developers, contractors, or property owners who are required by City Ordinance or a City Council resolution to recycle construction and demolition debris. The City Ordinance requires applicants to recycle construction and demolition debris for any construction, addition, alteration, and demolition projects that are subject to the mandatory measures in the most current version of the construction waste reduction, disposal, and recycling sections of the California Green Building Standards Code. These forms shall be used for tracking and documentation. Applicants shall divert (recycle) no less than 65 percent of all construction and/ or demolition debris. Quantities shall be based on weight unless volume is a more appropriate measurement. City Council resolutions for specific projects may have higher recycling standards.

Applicants must submit receipts from the approved haulers or facilities that collected or received project C&D debris showing the actual weight or volume of each material, and/ or detail reports from the approved facility or vendor that generally match the same materials identified on the WMP. To count toward meeting the diversion requirement, the documentation (receipts or detail reports) must include:

- a. Receipts/weight tags from approved haulers or approved recycling facilities;
- b. The City of Newark officially listed as the city of origin;
- c. All of the materials generated by the project, including materials generated and hauled by subcontractors;
- d. Receipts/weight tags that were generated within the date range that the permit was active with the permit number indicated; and,
- e. Any additional information the applicant believes is relevant to determining its efforts to comply in good faith with this chapter.

Weighing of Wastes: Applicants shall make reasonable efforts to ensure that all C&D debris diverted or placed in a landfill are measured and recorded using the most accurate method of measurement available. To the extent practical, all C&D debris shall be weighed by measurement on scales. Such scales shall comply with all regulatory requirements for accuracy and maintenance. For C&D debris for which weighing is not practical due to small size or other considerations, a volumetric measurement shall be used.
